- ^{5.} Unless you are looking to do Pre-Med, most students choose either Physics 105 (Frontiers in Astronomy) or Physics 187 (Conceptual Physics)
- ^{6.} You may choose from any of the Magis Common Core: II Undrst SS. However, PSY 201 (requirement for HCB students) also fulfills this Magis Common Core requirement. You will only receive 3 credit hours, but able to fulfill both requirements with one course – PSY 201.
- ^{7.} Any class with a prefix of ART, ARH, DAN, MUS, or THR.
- ^{8.} Select among ACC 538, ECO 528, FIN 558, MKT 363, ECO 518, ECO 538, MGT 373. If you also apply the global business class to your major, you must take an additional business elective.
- ^{9.} There are three options for the modern language or culture requirement:
 - (1) one or two courses in French, German, Italian, Japanese, Russian, Arabic or Spanish. Students must complete through the 112 level or above.
 - (2) One course in French, German, Italian, Japanese, Russian, Arabic or Spanish, and one global studies class (history, political science); the language must be spoken in the region; one class must be 200 level or above.
 - (3) Two global studies courses. Both classes must focus on the same country or region.
- ^{10.} A third business elective is only needed if the Global Business Class is also counted as one of the elective classes within the chosen major.
