



Need help filing your taxes?

We can do it for **FREE!**

The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) Program at Creighton University offers free help to individuals who have income less than \$57,000 and need help preparing their federal and state tax returns. This service is open to both low- and-moderate income earners as well as students.

All clients must be able to participate virtually. You will need access to a computer or other device that allows you to participate in a zoom meeting (a telephone conference using a computer) while your return is being prepared and reviewed.

PLEASE DO NOT ATTEMPT TO ATTEND ONE OF THE CLINICS IN PERSON – YOU WILL BE DENIED ENTRY.

To prepare your return remotely, first, follow the instructions on page 2 to upload your tax documentation. Then, join us during one of the clinic dates over Zoom to prepare your taxes!

No appointment necessary. Simply join the Zoom at a time that is most convenient for you.

Our clinics meet all requirements of the IRS and the Internal Revenue Code in terms of protecting your personal identity and your documents. We receive your documents in a secure manner and file the finished electronic return directly with the IRS through its proprietary software. Once we have completed and reviewed the return, we delete any files that contain your personal information other than what is necessary to retain for correspondence with the IRS.

Instructions for uploading tax documentation to Google drive (To be completed before joining the Zoom)

- 1) *On a computer, go to [Google drive](#) and sign in with an email and password.
- 2) At the top left, click New > File Upload or Folder Upload and choose the file or folder you want to upload that contains all your tax documents listed below.
- 3) You can also upload files or folders by dragging them into the Google Drive folder.
- 4) **Upload the following documents: *If documents are not already electronic, you can use your phone to take clear pictures of or scan the documents and then upload them*
 - a. For **U.S. Citizens** or **Resident Aliens**, fill out and upload a **completed** [Form 13614-C](#)
 - b. For **Non-Resident Aliens**, fill out and upload a **completed** [Form 13614-NR](#) and:
 - i. A picture of your current Passport
 - ii. [Form I-94, Arrival and Departure Record](#)
 - c. Proof of identification (Photo ID) for all taxpayers to be included on your tax return – Please note: if you are married filing jointly, your spouse must be present on the Zoom call
 - d. Proof of Social Security Numbers for you, your spouse and your dependents; if you do not have a social security number, proof of Individual Taxpayer Identification Numbers (ITINs) for you, your spouse, and your dependents
 - e. Proof of foreign status, if applying for an ITIN
 - f. IRS-issued Taxpayer Identity Protection PIN, if received
 - g. Wage and earning statements (Form W-2, W-2G, 1099-R, 1099-Misc, etc.) from all employers and other payers
 - h. Interest and dividend statements from banks (Form 1099)
 - i. Health insurance statements (Form 1095)
 - j. Documentation of any donations made to U.S. charities
 - k. Total paid for daycare provider and the daycare provider's tax identifying number, such as their Social Security number or business Employer Identification Number
 - l. Copy of last year's federal and state returns, if available
 - m. **Students**, please also upload your Tuition Statement (Form 1098-T)
- 5) Have on hand:
 - a. Bank account routing number and account number for direct deposits
 - b. Birth dates for you, your spouse, and dependents

If you are having difficulties uploading your documents, a volunteer will be able to assist you during clinic hours. However, this may significantly slow the process of preparing your return.

After you have uploaded your documents, join us during a clinic date on Zoom to prepare your taxes:
